EDUCATIONAL NOTIFICATION OF LATERAL ENTRY ADMISSION INTO
3RD SEMESTER OF DIPLOMA ENGINEERING FROM ITI

Duly filled in **Online Applications** in prescribed format are invited from the eligible students for Lateral Entry Admission in Diploma Level Technical Institutes under the Dept. of Higher Education for ITI Pass-outs for admission in 2nd year (3rd semester) of Diploma Engineering Courses for Academic Session 2021-22 in Tripura Institute of Technology (Narsingarh), Women's Polytechnic (Hapania), Dhalai District Polytechnic (Ambassa), Gomati District Polytechnic (Udaipur), North Tripura District Polytechnic (Dharmanagar) and TTAADC Polytechnic Institute (Khumulwng) in vacant seats of different branches of the respective institutes under Higher Education Dept., Govt. of Tripura.

The process of application will be as follows:

N.B.:

1. All other related information related to the Lateral Admission are mentioned in the Prospectus available in the website www.highereducation.tripura.gov.in.
2. It is to be noted that admission of candidate in an institute will be subjected to merit position in the ITI Lateral Entry merit list, seat allotment through Online Counselling along with fulfillment of all eligibility criteria and other norms as specified by the Dept. of Higher Education and Central Selection Committee.

Guidelines for admission in Diploma Engineering through Lateral Entry Admission from ITI

- A. Candidates should be resident of Tripura and have valid PRTC.
- B. Candidates with Madhyamik or 10th standard passed with 2 years NCVT approved ITI courses (as per Table-1) will be eligible for taking admission into 2nd year (3rd semester) of Diploma Engineering through Lateral Entry Scheme.
- C. Intake capacity will be the 'unfilled vacancies in the first year' of the last academic session (2020-2021) plus '10% of the "Approved Intake" which shall be over and above i.e. supernumerary to the "Approved Intake"'.
D. No upper age limit for candidates for admission into Diploma Engineering as per AICTE.

- E. As per AICTE, candidates should have secured 35% marks in aggregate in Madhyamik or 10th standard or equivalent examination from TBSE/CBSE or any other TBSE recognized boards.
- F. Candidates shall produce all original documents including character certificate issued by Head of the Institute last attended or any Gazetted Officer. Such character certificates must be issued within six month before the date of document verification and admission.
- G. Reservation of unfilled vacancies will be as like the Roster of seats of the preceding first year and for additional 10% supernumerary seats new roster will be maintained as per the guidelines of state government.
- H. Mapping of ITI trades with corresponding Diploma Engineering Programmes shall be as follows:

- I. Registration and application should be done through online portal of DEEET-2021 maintained by CSC.
- J. Application fee of **Rs. 350/-** (for all candidate other than BPL) and **Rs. 200/-** (for BPL candidates) must be paid by the candidates through online mode.
- K. Beyond the examination fee, any payment gateway service charges would be borne by the candidates.

- L. Merit list will be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained in ITI examinations as reflected in Consolidated Statement of marks.
- M. Counselling will be done through online. During counselling students have to fill up their choice of Branch and Institute. After that, students will automatically be allotted with seats and an **Allotment Letter** will be generated which will be available in the portal for download and print. Students from any ITI trade will be allowed to take admission in corresponding Diploma Engineering Programme only as stated in **Table-1**.
- N. Reservation of seats will be as per norms set by Govt. of Tripura.
- O. Candidates must be physically present for producing all original documents at the time of taking admission in respective Polytechnics. The candidates also have to fulfill all formalities of respective Institutes.
- P. After completion of 1st round of counselling, there may be 2nd round and Spot counselling, if required, based on availability of seats, which will be done within the permitted time frame of admission process as per AICTE directives.
- Q. During Online Application, a candidate has to upload soft copy of current colour Photograph, full Signature and other documents, otherwise candidate will lose his/her candidature/claim of admission for the year. Detail list of documents are available in the prospectus.
- R. First round document verification will be done before publication of merit list. If documents of any candidate are found inappropriate/incorrect, in that case candidate will lose his/her candidature in the merit list.
- S. BPL candidates, seeking relaxation of fees must provide their unique Ration Card Number during online application process. After verification, if the claim of any candidate as BPL found false, then the candidate must pay the full fees as per their category. Otherwise, candidate will lose his / her candidature for the year.
- T. The candidates must produce hard copy of their '**online application confirmation page**' and photocopy of all relevant documents along with original documents during document verification and admission. Without verification of original documents, no candidate will be allowed to take admission. If documents of any candidate are found inappropriate/incorrect, in that case candidate will lose his/her candidature for taking admission.

Reservation:

Reservation of seats for SC / ST / Person with Disability (PwD)/ Wards of Ex-serviceman (ESM) candidates shall be as per the Reservation Policy of the Government of Tripura. In case of PwD, the percentage of disability and type of PwD will be as per Govt. norms. The certificate(s) issued by the appropriate authority (Rajya Sainik Board for ESM and Dept. of Social Welfare for PwD candidate) shall have to be produced at the time of document verification. In cases of ESM, the candidates **must endorse the Online Acknowledge Page from Rajya Sainik Board**.



Publication of Merit List & Online Counselling

Merit list will be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained in ITI final examinations as reflected in Consolidated Statement of marks. Merit List will be published in the websites: www.highereducation.tripura.gov.in and deet.tripura.gov.in portal. After the publication of the Merit List, the concerned candidates must make online choice feeding in the portal to participate in the online counseling process. The candidates, then, will have to collect **online Seat Allotment Letter** prior to movement for admission in respective Institutes.
